Recitation—VERBS: personal endings; tense endings: imperfect, future, perfect, pluperfect, future perfect; *amo* PP and conjugate in 6 tenses; *do, sto, juvo, lavo* irregular PP; *sum* in 6 tenses. *moneo* 6 tenses; irregular PP *timeo, valeo, doceo, teneo, ardeo, jubeo, maneo // gaudeo, caveo, video, sedeo, respondeo, moveo; Chant them over and over until you have them down.*

NOUNS: case names, (1DF) *mensa, -ae*; (2DusM) *servus, -i*; (2DumN) *bellum, -i.*; (3D M/F) *pater, patris*; (3DN) *nomen, nominis*; (4DM) *portus, portūs*; (5DF) *res, rei*
