 - ___ **Anemographia** (a vivid description of wind)
 - ___ **Dendrographia** (a vivid description of a tree)
 - ___ **Ethopoeia** (a **vivid** description of a character)
 - ___ **Astrothesia** (a vivid description of stars)
 - ___ **Chorographia** (a vivid description of a group, as a group -- not individuals)
 - ___ **Chronographia** (a vivid representation of a certain historical or recurring time)
 - ___ **Ecphrasis** (description of a person, event, place, season or other common thing)
 - ___ **Geographia** (**vivid** representation of the earth or landscape so that it can be envisioned)
